It was an amazing year for Intergroup. The year started out with a deep need of assistance to help restructure Intergroup. We proved the point that if you ask for help you will get it. So many people stepped up to the plate and we were able to accomplish so much in a short period of time.

### *Summary of 2004 accomplishments:*

- Set Prudent Reserve Target of \$15K and now 40% funded (\$6,000)
- Hired new Office Manager, Pam T.
- Expansion of office hours to include Saturdays from 10am - 3pm
- Increase in the product and literature lineup offered in the office.
- Created opportunities for people to volunteer in the office.
- Purchased 2 new computer monitors that were needed greatly.
- Added another phone line to handle heavier call volumes and create greater efficiency.
- Automated many of the office functions with Quickbooks.
- Enhanced financial reporting; creating greater transparency and accountability to our members.
- Created a cleaner and more professional office environment.
- Began adding new events to increase fellowship and revenues such as the Serenity Golf Scramble.
- Built a new website: [www.aainpalmbeach.org](http://www.aainpalmbeach.org) (Check it out!)

The energy and enthusiasm that people displayed in 2004 was inspirational and I can only imagine where that will take us in 2005. From a broad perspective, our goals for 2005 are to continue to focus on stabilizing finances, enhancing communications, improving existing services and adding services as needed. ## Intergroup Minutes, December 29, 2004

**Chairperson: Rick G** opened the meeting with the Serenity Prayer. Jimmy read the 12 traditions. New representatives introduced themselves, Tommy W. from Central House, Kerri A. from Spiritual Awakening, Tara H. from One Page At A Time, Delray Beach, and Lisa P from Primary Purpose. Rick highlighted South Palm Beach County Intergroup accomplishments for 2004: 1) set prudent reserve target of \$15K and now 40% funded; 2) expansion of office hours to include Saturdays; 3) increase in the product and literature lineup offered in the office; 4) began paying sales tax; 5) created opportunities for people to volunteer in the office; 6) upgraded some of the computer equipment; 7) added another phone line to handle increase in calls; 8) automated many of the office functions with Quickbooks; 9) enhanced financial reporting, creating greater transparency and accountability to our members; 10) created a cleaner and more professional environment in the office; 11) began adding new events to increase fellowship and revenues; 12) built out a new website: [www.aainpalmbeach.org](http://www.aainpalmbeach.org); 13) hired Pam T. as new office manager.

**Office Manager: Pam T** Intergroup office needs volunteers to help in the office. While all assistance is welcomed, 5 committed people are needed for weekly scheduled hours.

**Treasurer: John S** reported that the financials are continuing to improve, and the prudent reserve is now at \$6,000. John also reported that the 2003 Taxes have been filed.

**Gratitude Dinner: Stephan C** the Gratitude Dinner raised over \$6300.00. The Embassy Suites has offered the room for November 18, 2005.

**General Service Liaison: Jim M** the monthly district meeting was held on December 12<sup>th</sup>. There is still an opening for the Archives chair. New trusted servants were elected for Treasurer, Grapevine, and Special Needs. Additionally, many sub-districts need District Committee Members. Any current or former GSR is eligible to stand. In January, new officers will assume their roles in Palm Beach District 8 and in South Florida Area 15. The next Area meeting is 1/7-1/9 in Tampa. Due to the Quarterly, the next monthly District business meeting will be the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday, January 16<sup>th</sup>, at 5:45PM at the Triangle Club in West Palm.

**Telephone Relay: Albert M** reported that January and February are covered, but we need volunteers beginning in March. Albert also reported that he is working on a better phone rate plan for Intergroup.

**Special Events: Ray D** reported that several groups have shown interest in hosting an event for Intergroup. i.e. Bowling, Tennis, Old Timers, Picnic, Movie Screening, etc. Ray stated more will be announced at the January meeting.

**Group Information:** No report.

**Institutions Committee: Charlie O** reported that we are still bringing in just under 30 meetings per week. Last month we were \$400 in the red and now \$400 in the black. North County is donating a case of books each month for as long as we have a need.

**Public Information: Bill J** no report for this month.

**SCAAN/Web: David R** discussed the new website, [www.aainpalmbeach.org](http://www.aainpalmbeach.org). David also brought business cards with the web site name for rep's to bring back to their groups.

**Speaker Exchange: Barbara McG** reported that there were 14 requests for speakers and we currently have 20 women and 18 men on the speaker list.

**Where and When and Internet Liaison: Al A** reported that the new meeting lists are available and that all information is up to date. Al also reported that he is working closely with David R to keep the web page up to date on all meetings schedules. ....Continued on pg. 3

Financials and Group Contributions listed in the SCAAN – The topic of how to save money and still get the financial information to the membership was discussed. To add the financial information to the SCAAN quarterly instead of monthly; to add the financials to the web page instead of printing in the SCAAN each month and groups could print out and take to their groups; the importance of Intergroup being accountable to the membership it was suggested keeping the financial information in the SCAAN and also add to the web page. A Motion was made that each group rep bring this back to their group and report back at the January Meeting. Motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

Intergroup Inventory – Rick G reported that Intergroup will be taking an inventory during 2005. To get the memberships views and suggestions on improvements, a questionnaire was presented with a question for each month for the group rep to take to their business meeting for discussion and report back at the next Intergroup meeting. January will be question number 1.

Speaker Exchange, Barbara McG presented to the membership a change in the procedure for how groups could get their speakers. Barbara suggested that instead of a group calling the Speaker Exchange to obtain a speaker that they would come to the Intergroup Meeting and trade with another group. The trade would be if you want a speaker you also give a speaker. After much discussion, it was suggested that group rep's take this back to their meetings to discuss and report back at the January Intergroup meeting.

A Motion was made by Eric to pay for 2 nights lodging and travel for our office manager Pam to attend the Quarterly in Tampa on January 8 and 9. Motion was seconded and unanimously carried.

**District 8 – South Palm Beach County Intergroup (4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2004) Report to South Florida Area 15**

South Palm Beach County Intergroup which held it's very first meeting on May 2, 1984, turned 20 years old in 2004. Twenty-nine members attended the first SPBC Intergroup meeting and elected eleven trusted servants forming our first Steering Committee. An office was rented and volunteers manned the phones. Our first Where & When listed 31 groups.

Now, 20 years later, we have 127 groups and 251 meetings in our Where & When. Our office is open from 9-5 Mon through Fri, and 10-3 on Saturdays. We are fully computerized and use Quickbooks accounting system to maintain our financial records for accountability to our membership. With the help of Fund Raising events, we have established a Prudent Reserve with a year end balance of \$5,850. Our new website, [www.aainpalmbeach.org](http://www.aainpalmbeach.org) is fully operational offering meeting times, location maps, events calendar, online shopping, and links to NPBC meetings and all Intergroups in Area 15 with websites. We receive over 200 emails monthly at our new email address, [southcountyaa@bellsouth.net](mailto:southcountyaa@bellsouth.net) requesting information, or offering information.

During the second half of 2004, we had a marked increase in office activity, donations and 2 very successful fund raising events:

Julie volunteers on Monday mornings, and keeps our pamphlets organized and inventoried; Nikki and Sandy volunteer on Tuesdays, helping with phones and placing orders; and 3 temporary volunteers who come in as needed, Kerri, Kevin & Rick. I am truly grateful for these trusted servants.*

*I now have 4 treatment centers who order all their literature by the case through our Intergroup; and Central House has a standing order for pamphlets and Where & Whens, plus ordering books by the case. These larger orders are increasing our profits slowly but steadily, and I will continue to reach out to the recovery community for their support. Please continue to spread the word that Intergroup can special order the same recovery items you are buying "on the Avenue", sell at a lower price, and still make a profit for SPBC.*

*For anyone who has not visited our website: [www.aainpalmbeach.org](http://www.aainpalmbeach.org), please do so! David R. has added an Online Catalog of items you can purchase through Intergroup and I am researching the possibility of accepting credit cards for these purchases. I have also checked into UPS shipping costs, and we could offer this service if people are willing to pay the full cost for shipping and supplies.*

*Calls are increasing, and 12 Step needs are ever present. I am asking each Intergroup Rep to bring in 1 name of someone from their group, willing to talk to a suffering Alcoholic who has made that first call to AA....."When anyone, anywhere, reaches out for help, I want the hand of AA always to be there. And for that: I am responsible."*
